WELCOME TO DISTRICT INDUSTRIES CENTRE, WANAPARTHY



Rivers and Lakes

River Krishna flows through the District at Pebbair. The district also has 2301 minor irrigation tanks. In addition Govt. of Telangana has accorded sanctions for restoration of 102 lakes under Mission Kakatiya Phase-I and 332 lakes under Mission Kakatiya Phase-II. Due to this there is good scope for increase in irrigated areas and also encouragement for fisheries sector in the district.
