ORDER:

During the Annual General Meeting of Bulk Drug Manufacturers Association (BDMA) on 17.9.2010, it was represented to the Govt. that in order to regain pre-eminent position in manufacturing and to achieve optimum export potential of the Bulk Drugs/Pharma Industry in A.P., there is a need to constitute a Special Advisory Group/Task Force, which can work out strategies and come out with recommendations, from time to time, for this purpose.

2. Considering the importance of the matter and the need for working out concerted strategies for the growth of pharmaceutical sector in the State, Government after careful consideration, decided to constitute an Advisory Committee involving representatives and experts in the field and accordingly, hereby constitute the Pharma Advisory Committee (PAC) with the following members to suggest strategies for growth of pharmaceutical /bulk drugs sector in the State and to give recommendations to the Government on policy initiative required, from time to time:
