ORDER:

In exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Act, 2014 (Act No.3 of 2014), Government has issued Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Rules, 2015 vide G.O.3rd read above for implementation of the provisions of the said Act.

2. In order to facilitate the investors by providing investor friendly environment, mandate time-bound delivery of all services, Government vide G.O.s 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th read above, issued certain amendments to Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Rules, 2015 issued in G.O.3rd read above and brought certain services pertaining to establishment and operation of the Industries under TS-iPASS including two (2) services pertaining to Labour Department viz., “Registration under Shops and Establishments Act” and “Renewal of Registration under Shops and Establishments Act” with time lines of 30 days each.

3. In the reference 10th read above, DIPP has communicated BRAP-2019 with the following recommendations pertaining to Labour, Employment, Training & Factories (LET&F) Department and the issue was taken up with the Labour, Employment, Training & Factories (LET&F) Department to indicate the timelines, additions to the TS-iPASS online Common Application Form and initiate the integration procedure with TS-iPASS online portal:

- a. Ensure that the Final Registration is granted within one day from the date of application;
- b. Eliminate the requirement of renewal of registration.

4. In the reference 11th read above, the Government in LET&F Department have issued clarification that, vide Act. No.28/2017, amendment to Telangana Shops and Establishment Act, 1988, the requirement of inspection prior to registration has been dispensed with. The amendment act provides that within (24) business hours, provisional registration certificate has to be issued. As the inspection prior to registration is dispensed with, in order to facilitate Registration under the Telangana Shops and establishment act, 1988, final order and issue of certificate of registration shall also be completed within (24) business hours from the time of online uploading of application for registration with other enclosures as may be prescribed. Further, in order to eliminate the requirement of renewal of registration, the registration certificate under the Telangana Shops and Establishment Act, 1988, once issued, may be treated as permanent. However, the employer shall continue to pay the fee prescribed for extending the validity of registration by 1st December of every year.
