ORDER:-

Whereas, basing on the recommendations of the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad in the second read above, Government of Telangana in the third read above have issued orders "exempting for all shops and establishments from sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Act for issue of final registration certificate within one day from the date of uploading of application along with enclosures as may be prescribed and also exemption from section 4 of the Act for granting renewal of registration certificate subjected to payment of annual fee by the employer for extending the validity of registration by 1st December of every year";

2. And whereas, the Special Commissioner of Labour in the reference fourth read above have *inter - alia* made one of the recommendation for liberalization of regulations for shops and commercial establishments which should be without request of approval, on an intimation basis and thus, the State may allow this registration till the life of the establishment and further suggested it should be deemed licensing approach and to be registered under the Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 (Act No.20 of 1988);

3. After careful examination of the said recommendations, the Government have decided to amend the notification issued in the G.O. third read above, so as to issue final registration on intimation of the self-registration basis.

4. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in an Extraordinary Issue of the Telangana Gazette, Dated:25.06.2026:-
