ORDER:

In exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TG-iPASS) Act, 2014 (Act No.3 of 2014), Government has issued Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TG-iPASS) Rules,2015 vide G.O.3rd read above for implementation of the provisions of the said Act.

2. In the reference 5th read above, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India communicated Ease of Doing Business (EoDB), Business Reform Action Plan for the year 2024 with 287 reforms pertaining to 13 Secretariat departments and 26 HoDs. The new reforms have mandated development of certain provisions under TG-iPASS.

3. Accordingly, new services are brought under the purview of TG-iPASS to be delivered within timelines mandated by Public Service Delivery Guarantee Act. Subsequently, the concerned departments have issued necessary orders/ amendments as mandated under EoDB reforms.

4. In addition to this, DPIIT vide reference 7th read above, has included 70 new reforms under Business Reforms Action Plan plus (BRAP+) category for the states to implement which covers 70 new reforms pertaining to 5 Secretarial departments and 9 HoDs. In the action plan, 1 service is newly included under BRAP+ 2024.

5. Government, after careful examination of the matter, hereby issue the following amendments to the TG-iPASS Rules,2015:

AMENDMENTS

Amendment I: The following provisions are appended in TG-iPASS Rules (amended from time to time) under Rule (8) of the G.O. 3rd read above:

8(a) Online Dashboards in TG-iPASS:

An online dashboard is developed in the TG-iPASS portal for the following service. The details are available at <https://ipass.telangana.gov.in/>

- i. Department wise approvals (Manufacturing and services sector)

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- ii. Number of queries / grievances handled, and the time taken to resolve. (Manufacturing and services sector)
- iii. Incentives with details regard to number of applications received and granted and time taken. Fee details shall not be applicable.
- iv. One District One Product (ODOP)

All these dashboards shall be updated on real time basis.

8(b) Online Dashboard for all Departments:

All the state departments have developed online dashboard with features related to Department-wise approval timelines for registration/renewal/license timelines prescribed as per the Public Service Delivery Guarantee (PSDG) Act, total number of applications received, number of applications approved, average, median and minimum time taken for obtaining approvals, along with the average fee for completion of entire process. Application-wise details are made available on the online portal with regard to date of application, date of approval and breakup of fee details.

The dashboard is developed in the following format:

For new connections and registrations, application-wise details are updated in the online portal with regard to date of application, date of approval and breakup of fee details with the following features.

8 (c) Compliance Dashboard:

The dashboard is developed for all business units to review and track their timely adherence to compliances/ approvals/ licenses/ NoCs/returns/renewals etc. The dashboard displays/highlights whenever there is pendency or due date for compliance is approaching. Units/firms shall be informed 30 days prior to the due date through SMS/Email alert. The alerts are pre-scheduled and auto generated. Area-wise reports on adherence to compliances/lapses/delays are displayed on the dashboard to monitor the efficiency on timely adherence of all the compliances. A scorecard mechanism for rating the units/firms is introduced based on timely adherence to compliances.

8(d) PAN as Single Business ID:

TG-iPASS system has integrated with National Single Window System (NSWS) with PAN as the unique identifier for enabling all Approvals/Registrations/

NOC/ Renewals/ Amendments/Compliance Requirements/ Schemes related transactions. PAN number is validated at the time of registration and shall auto-fetch common information and documents across systems to ensure authenticity and quicker processing of applications.

8(e) Online single window system-Decriminalization

An online system is developed for all the criminal provisions under various Acts including sections of all the State departments in the TG-iPASS portal with the details of event point for incidence of liability and associated Penalty and imprisonment period.

Amendment II: In annexure-VI, under "Other Public Delivery Services", the following service shall be appended at Sl.No.105.
