**ORDER:-**

The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Development (MSMED) Act, 2006 (Central Act No.27 of 2006), contains provisions of Delayed Payment to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSES). In the G.O third read above, the Government of Telangana have issued "The Telangana State Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council (TSMSEFC)" Rules, 2017.

2. The Regional Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Councils will conduct conciliation or dispute resolution or arbitration by passing an award/ decree/order in this regard on a reference made to council by Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) for delayed payments from buyers.

3. In the D.O. Letter Seventh read above, Secretary Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise Government of India, New Delhi has advised, all the State Governments to make a provision for recovery of decree or award made by Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Councils (MSEFC) under The Revenue Recovery Act 1890 (Central Act I of 1890) and shall be executed by concerned District Collectors for speedy recovery of pending amount from buyers. Further the Secretary, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise, Government of India has also mentioned that the Government of Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand and Bihar have made such provisions in their rules.

4. The Commissioner of Industries, Hyderabad in his Letter 9<sup>th</sup> read above has requested the Government to issue necessary orders/notification by making provisions for recovery of decree or award made by Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Councils under the Revenue Recovery Act 1890 ( Central Act No. I of 1890) in our State also.

5. Government after careful examination of the matter have decided to amend the Telangan State Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation council Rules, 2017 issued in the G.O. Third read above.

6. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in an Extraordinary issue of the Telangana State Gazette, dated:04.03.2021.

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 read with sub-section (3) of section 21 of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (Central Act No.27 of 2006), the Government of Telangana hereby makes the following amendment to the Telangana State Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council Rules, 2017, issued in G.O.Ms.No.39, Industries and Commerce (FP & MSMSE) Department, dated: 30.06.2017:-

**1. Short title extent and commencement:**

- (i) These rules may be called the "Telangana State Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council (Amendment) Rules, 2021".


- (ii) They shall extend to the whole of the Telangana State.
- (iii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette of Telangana State.
2. In the Telangana State Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council Rules, 2017, after rule 14, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely, - "14A"- **Recovery of amount due as arrears of land Revenue:-** if a buyer does not file any appeal under section 19 of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (Central Act No.27 of 2006) for setting aside any decree, award or other order made by either council itself or by any institution or centre or if such appeal is dismissed, in that situation such decree, award or order shall be executed by the Collector of the District concerned and the amount due shall be recovered as arrears of land revenue".
7. The Commissioner of Industries, Telangana, Hyderabad is requested to take necessary further action in the matter.
